Ageing:

This exceptional white wine, Serai, is produced from a carefully selected blend of Turbiana, Pinot Bianco, Chardonnay, and Sauvignon Blanc grapes. The grapes are hand-harvested in early September and undergo soft crushing before fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature of 16°C. After fermentation, the wine is aged for a minimum of one month in the bottle.

Descriptions for Wine List:

Serai presents a brilliant light yellow color with pale green reflections. The nose offers a delightful bouquet of floral and fruity aromas, featuring notes of green apple, pear, and apricot. On the palate, it showcases a pleasantly dry flavor with fresh acidity and a delicate smoothness. This wine pairs beautifully with various fish dishes or can be enjoyed as an aperitif. Serve chilled at 10° - 12°C in medium-sized glasses for the best experience.
