## Story of the wine:

Vite Colte is an astonishing co-operative right in the heart of Barolo, Piemonte. A stunning and state of the art winery, producing over fifty styles of indigenous wines ranging from Gavi di Gavi, Barbera, Barolo and Barbaresco. The Vite Colte protocol has only just one goal: an absolute and constant quality standard, the result of agronomic choices aimed at sustainable, selective vineyard management focused on achieving perfectly ripe fruit. Every winegrower complies with the protocol, taking prompt action in the vineyard and defining and monitoring the progress of their work in close contact with the company's team of agronomists. With the top 15% winegrowers in the area, you can always expect a good glass of wine from ViteColte. The Label and name are registered as they are works of the famous poet, Cesare Pavese. *Tra Donne Sole (The Lonely Girl)* was one of nine novels he wrote.

100% Sauvignon

## Area:

Piemonte, Italy

## Av. age of the vines:

15-19 Years old

## Ageing:

The vineyards are located in two different areas, meaning that the grapes ripen at different times: one being slightly earlier, offering the acidity and wealth of aromas typical of Sauvignon, and the other slightly later, offering extractive wealth and aromas of tropical fruit. After alcoholic fermentation, the wine rests and decants at a low temperature on lees for at least 3 months on lees.

## Descriptions for Wine List:

Straw yellow with golden hues in colour. On the nose, opulent and intense white flower driven, slight sweet notes of lychee with undertones of tomato leaf and elderflower. Very complex. Interesting on the pallet, ripe cooking apple, vanilla and slight liquorice notes. Beautifully balanced, elegant and strong finish. Drinkability is outstanding with great flavour intensity.
