



### Story of the wine:

Hannes Reeh is located in Burgenland, within the Neusiedlersee area, where the warm Pannonian climate and long hours of sunshine allow for ripe, expressive fruit and a range of wine styles from dry to sweet. The estate, spanning extensive vineyard holdings, focuses on modern, fruit-driven winemaking while maintaining a clear sense of place.

The Cuvée Süß is part of the Heideboden series, named after the local terroir, which contributes richness, aromatic depth, and balance to the wines. This sweet cuvée is crafted from carefully selected grapes to capture natural ripeness and concentration, offering a harmonious dessert wine that reflects both the climate and varietal character of the region.

### Varietals:

Welschriesling, Sämpling 88 (Scheurebe)

### Area:

Neusiedlersee - Burgenland, Austria

### Ageing:

Selected ripe grapes are harvested and fermented in stainless steel tanks to preserve aromatic purity and freshness. Fermentation is stopped to retain residual sugar, resulting in a naturally sweet style. The wine is then matured briefly in stainless steel, with no oak influence, to maintain clarity and varietal expression.

### Descriptions for Wine List:

Pale golden in colour with an aromatic profile of ripe stone fruits, citrus zest, and floral notes. The palate is rich yet balanced, combining sweetness with fresh acidity, showing flavours of peach, apricot, and subtle tropical hints, leading to a clean, elegant finish. Well-suited to both dessert pairings and rich savoury dishes.
