Story of the wine:

Conejo Negro is part of Grupo Salute, a contemporary wine project focused on producing approachable, fruit-driven wines with a modern, accessible style.

The fruit is sourced from Finca Bautem, a family-owned vineyard project established by the Mayo family in 2010 in Barrancas, Maipú (Mendoza). Originally entering the wine industry as grape growers, the estate now supplies high-quality fruit to leading Argentine wineries including Trapiche, Catena Zapata, and Kaiken.

Combining advanced vineyard technology-NDVI monitoring, drones, and precision agriculture-with a strong focus on sustainability, Finca Bautem delivers consistent quality. Conejo Negro represents the more playful, easy-drinking side of the portfolio, designed for immediate enjoyment without compromising on vineyard pedigree.

Varietals:

100% Malbec

Area:

Barrancas, Maipú, Mendoza, Argentina. Estate-grown fruit from Finca Bautem (approx. 750m altitude)

Av. age of the vines:

18-22 Years

Vinification:

Medium-scale, quality-focused production. Hand-harvested between February and April at optimal ripeness. Fermentation in stainless steel with temperature control to preserve fruit purity and varietal character. Short maturation in tank to retain freshness and drinkability

Descriptions for Wine List:

Deep ruby in colour. The nose shows ripe blackberry and plum with subtle spice. The palate is smooth and fruit-forward with soft tannins and balanced acidity.

Juicy, approachable, and easy-drinking with a clean finish-ideal for casual dining and by-the-glass.
